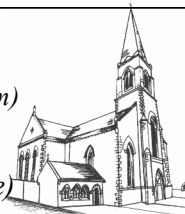

of a dignified life.

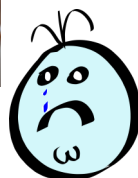
