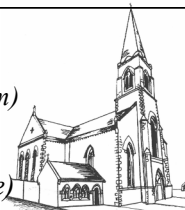

### Fratelli Tutti: Brothers and Sisters All

This is Pope Francis' third encyclical, given in Assisi, at the tomb of St Francis, 3rd October 2020, the title comes from a term borrowed from the writings of St Francis of Assisi. The encyclical offers a blueprint for a better and more just post-Covid world.

#### Pope Francis' Ecumenical Christian Prayer

*O God, Trinity of love,  
from the profound communion  
of your divine life,  
pour out upon us a torrent of fraternal love.  
Grant us the love reflected in the actions of  
Jesus, in his family of Nazareth,  
and in the early Christian community.  
Grant that we Christians may live the Gospel,  
discovering Christ in each human being,  
recognizing him crucified in the sufferings of  
the abandoned and forgotten of our world,  
and risen in each brother or sister who makes  
a new start.  
Come, Holy Spirit, show us your beauty,  
reflected in all the peoples of the earth,  
so that we may discover anew  
that all are important and all are necessary,  
different faces of the one humanity  
that God so loves. Amen.*
