Public Mass and the Celebration of the Sacraments

Everyone is welcome to attend Mass once again. There is no need to book beforehand. Numbers are restricted to **100** for Public Mass.

We have two zones or pods which operate independently and may accommodate **50 each**. Each section has its own entrance and exit route. There must be no movement of people between sections before, during or after Mass

Funerals restricted to **50** mourners (zones do not apply): this applies to church and the graveyard.

Weddings restricted to **50** guests in the chapel (zones do not apply).

Baptisms restricted to parents, child and siblings, godparents & grandparents, for the month of June.
