

Monday 29th June: Public Worship Resumes

It is a relief that the church can open again at the end of the month for public worship, subject to following the most up-to-date public health advice and associated regulations and obligations. Easing our way into celebrating public Masses and Baptisms will be a gradual process, doing things with care and consideration and learning as we go along.

To protect ourselves and others from the serious threat that COVID-19 still presents us with, we have to adhere strictly to

Physical distancing (currently 2 metres)

Good hand hygiene

Respiratory etiquette

Regular cleaning and sanitising of shared spaces

To implement these measures we need some volunteers to help out on a regular basis.

The dispensation from the Sunday and Holyday obligation is extended for the time being.

In terms of public Masses consider the following:

Instead of thinking in terms of Weekday Masses and Sunday Masses, consider all Masses as 'Sunday Masses'. In all, we would have eight Masses during the week (Saturday 7pm, Sunday 9am & 11am, Monday 10am, Tuesday 10am, Wednesday 7pm, Thursday 10am and Friday 7pm) and each person to attend only one Mass.

This would give everyone an opportunity to attend Mass once a week. All eight Masses would be given the same consideration (in terms of content and length, similar to the present weekday Mass). Those who consider themselves vulnerable would be advised not to attend. All Masses will be live-streamed as usual.

There will be designated areas for seating. Someone will be available to assist. Under Covid regulations the church may only accommodate 50 units (individuals/families). Everyone needs to be patient as this is new to all of us.

In terms of Holy Communion this could be done at the very end of Mass: receive communion and then leave. This would minimize movement in an enclosed space and would be the safer option.

There are many other points to consider but please ponder the above for now.

Hold up the World

What if we thought about prayer as a building block, as a foundation which holds up the world?

What if the only reason the world still exists is because there are those who pray and hold up the world with their faith, their belief, and their prayers.

May we hold up the world each day by offering up our prayers for ourselves, for others, for our communities, for our countries and for the world.
