### Public Mass

We happily resumed the public celebration of Mass on Monday 10th May.

There is no obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and Holy Days during these pandemic times. Every person should consider carefully if returning to public worship is the safe and appropriate step for them to take at this time. Livestreaming is always available.

Under existing guidelines, our church can be divided into two zones or two pods:

**Zone A** (St Catherine's side) and **Zone B** (Our Lady's side)

Each zone is independent and may accommodate **50 each**.

Social distancing guidelines must be adhered to

Each section has its own entrance and exit route

There must be no movement of people between sections before, during or after Mass

- Please consider each Mass as a Sunday Mass and if you wish to attend, please do so only once a week so that everyone gets an opportunity to attend
- For your once-a-week attendance at Mass, we would encourage more people to attend during the week so that the demand at the weekend is not too great

We are grateful to everyone who is helping with sanitising and stewarding.  
It is very much appreciated.

**First Holy Communion** has been arranged for Saturday 18th September (similar to last year) but First Confessions will take place early June.

**The Celebration of Confirmation** can hopefully be arranged before the young people move on to the Vocational School, sometime after the schools close in June and before September, perhaps early July. We will be in a better position to arrange a date in a month's time (similar format to last year).

**The Celebration of Baptism** For the months of May and June attendance will be restricted to 6 people. The situation should change by July.

**Funerals** restricted to 50 mourners (zones do not apply): this applies to the church and the graveyard. 'Related events, either before or after, should not take place'.

**Weddings** restricted to 50 guests in the chapel (zones do not apply).  
'For celebrations/receptions, a maximum of 6 people for indoor gatherings and 15 people for outdoor gatherings'.

Wash your hands often... keep a distance of 2 metres from others... wear a face covering...

sanitise your hands on entering and leaving the church

The church is open for private prayer every day: 8am - 8pm. Take care.

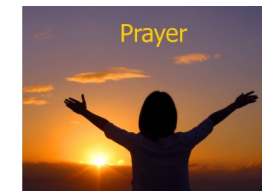
