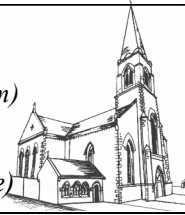

Mass at 10am.

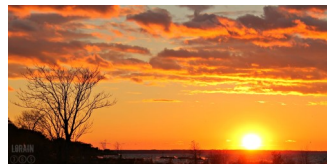
Novena of Masses for the Faithful Departed begins on Monday 2nd November 10am and continues throughout the month of November.

is in Sligo Cathedral.

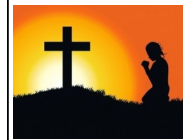
