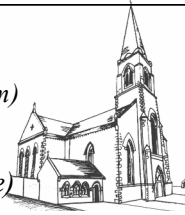

The following is a letter from the Primary Care Manager Sandra Sheerin to all patients in Dunkineely Health Centre:
I wish to advise you that Dr Charles McManus has formally resigned from the GMS practice in Dunkineely. Dr McManus has provided a wonderful service to patients in this area for many years and in addition since April this year has provided GP cover to the people of Lettermacaward, Fintown and Doochary, but he has decided to take up a post in another area and we want to thank him for his service and wish him well. The HSE in Donegal have advertised the position in Dunkineely and we are working hard to recruit a permanent replacement doctor for this area. At this time however we have not finalised that process and we have to put an interim arrangement in place. From Monday 21st November Dr McManus has agreed to provide a GP service for you from the Health Centre in Glenties, until a full time GP service is returned to Dunkineely. Please note that if you need to visit the GP you should call 0749557811 to make an appointment. I apologise for any inconvenience this arrangement may cause you, but I can confirm that this is only an interim arrangement.
