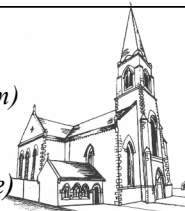

Public Worship Resumes Shortly

We look forward to returning to public worship. Easing our way into public Masses needs to be done with great care and consideration, doing all we can to protect ourselves and others from the serious threat that we continue to face from COVID-19.

Basic restrictions need to be observed strictly:

Keep a distance of 2 metres from others

Use hand-sanitizer both on entry and leaving

Respiratory etiquette - consider using a face mask

Avoid touching any surfaces if possible



To implement safety measures we need volunteers to help out.

With that in mind there will be a **meeting in the Church this Monday 22nd June 7pm.**

While this current COVID crisis persists, there is **no obligation** whatsoever on anyone to attend Mass.

If you feel you are vulnerable in any way, it is better not to attend.

Please regard all Masses from the week beginning **Monday 29th June to Sunday 5th July** as 'Sunday Masses' and the same for subsequent weeks. If you wish to attend Mass, there are a number of considerations.

- Numbers attending are restricted to **50 units** (individuals / couples / families).
- It means you may attend only **one Mass** per week in order to give everyone else an opportunity to attend Mass once a week. We would ask you to adhere strictly to this recommendation: each person to attend only **one Mass** a week.
- There will be **designated areas** for seating and someone will be on hand to assist.
- To help with physically distancing we suggest that the **kneelers** will not be used as this will ensure that people are 2 metres apart at all times. We are suggesting that you sit or stand only but not kneel.
- **Holy Communion** will be distributed at the end of Mass; after the Final Blessing, you may receive Communion as you are leaving the Church (this minimises movement in an enclosed space and is the safer option).
- We ask everyone to be **patient** and to show consideration as we gather for worship, taking baby steps and learning as we go.
- All Masses will be live-streamed and the 8 'Sunday Masses' per week will be given the **same consideration** in terms of content & length, similar to the present weekday Mass.

Monday week will see the first tentative step in a long process of getting back to a new normal.
