Graveyard Week

Graveyard Week begins tomorrow, Monday 27th July, and continues to Monday 3rd August.

- During these 8 days all who are buried in the graveyard will be remembered at all Masses.
- You are encouraged to pay a visit to the graveyard during that period and bless the graves of your loved ones.
- Holy Water bottles are freely available, along with a special Prayer of Blessing, at Scáthlán Mhuire in the Graveyard.
- Fr Colm will have a Service of Blessing at the graveyard, remembering all the deceased, especially those who died during the past year. This Service will be posted on the parish website and on killybegsonline.
- While maintaining the graves of your loved ones, please ensure all excess material is removed from the graveyard. A skip is now in place for that purpose (for graveyard use only).

A Very Gradual Return to Public Masses

Masses will be at the following times:

Monday & Tuesday morning 10am, Wednesday evening 7pm, Thursday morning 10am, Friday evening 7pm, Saturday evening 7pm, Sunday morning 9am & 11am

- There is no obligation to attend Mass.
- If you feel sick or vulnerable please stay at home and go online / TV / Radio.
- Please attend Mass only **once** a week. This will give everyone a chance.
- Keep a distance of 2 metres from others; use hand-sanitizer both on entry and leaving
- Respiratory etiquette - consider using a face mask; avoid touching any surfaces if possible
- Numbers attending Mass are restricted to **50**.
- Only occupy a **vacant seat** (no sharing of seats except with family members).
- A **one-way system** will operate: you enter by the main door and leave to the left or right of the altar (through the Adoration Room or by the side door on the hospital side).
- **Kneelers** are not in use (to ensure that people are 2 metres apart).
- **Holy Communion** will be distributed at the end of Mass; after the Final Blessing, you may receive Communion as you leave the Church (this minimises movement in an enclosed space).
- **Two collection boxes** on the newsletter tables on either side as you enter, baskets placed at the exits.
- All Masses will be live-streamed and all 8 weekly Masses will be given the **same consideration**.
- A **Bottle of Holy Water** is freely available at exits for each household.
- **Mass Attendance:** Friday 37, Sat 33, Sunday 45 & 47, Mon 17, Tue 20, Wed 34, Thursday 28.
