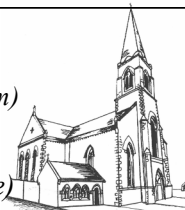

- ◆ All Baptisms need to be rescheduled.
- ◆ The church remains open for private prayer 8.00am to 8.00pm.
- ◆ While visiting the church, please observe all covid guidelines for your own protection and for the protection of others.
- ◆ These new restrictions apply until 16th October.

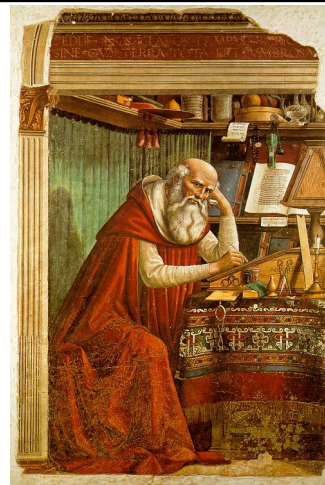
