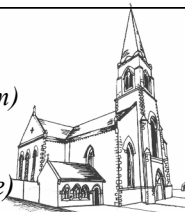

A Very Gradual Return to Public Masses

We will ease our way very gradually and gently into the celebration of Public Masses taking health and safety regulations very seriously.

Masses will be at the following times:

Monday 10am
Tuesday 10am
Wednesday 7pm
Thursday 10am
Friday 7pm
Saturday 7pm
Sunday 9am
Sunday 11am

- There is no obligation to attend Mass.
- If you feel vulnerable you might consider staying at home and go online / TV / Radio.
- If attending Mass please attend only **once** a week or a fortnight. This will give everyone a chance. Regard each Mass as a Sunday Mass.

Basic guidelines need to be observed strictly:

Keep a distance of 2 metres from others

Use hand-sanitizer both on entry and leaving

Respiratory etiquette - consider using a face mask

Avoid touching any surfaces if possible



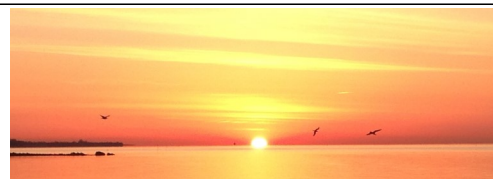
- * We need more **volunteers** to help out. We will meet this Sunday 12 noon in the Church.
- * Numbers attending Mass are restricted to **50 units** (individuals / couples / families).
- * There will be **designated areas** for seating and someone will be on hand to assist.
- * A **one-way system** will operate: you enter by the main door and leave to the left or right of the altar (through the Adoration Room or by the side door on the hospital side).
- * **Kneelers** will not be in use. This ensures that people are 2 metres apart at all times.
- * **Holy Communion** will be distributed at the end of Mass; after the Final Blessing, you may receive Communion as you leave the Church (this minimises movement in an enclosed space)
- * **Two collection boxes** will be placed on the newsletter tables on either side as you enter.
There will also be baskets placed at the exits.
- * We ask everyone to be **patient** and to show consideration as we gather for worship.
- * All Masses will be live-streamed and the 'eight Sunday Masses' per week will be given the **same consideration** in terms of content & length.

This Monday will see the first tentative step in a long process of getting back to a new normal.
