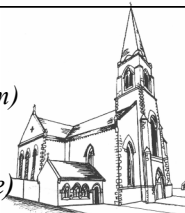

A Very Gradual Return to Public Masses

Masses will be at the following times:

Monday 10am	• There is no obligation to attend Mass.
Tuesday 10am	• If you feel sick or vulnerable please stay at home and go online / TV / Radio.
Wednesday 7pm	• If attending Mass please attend only once a week or a fortnight. This will give everyone a chance. Regard each Mass as a Sunday Mass.

*Keep a distance of 2 metres from others; Use hand-sanitizer both on entry and leaving
Respiratory etiquette - consider using a face mask; Avoid touching any surfaces if possible*

- * Only occupy a **vacant seat** (no sharing of seats except with family members).
- * Numbers attending Mass are restricted to **50**.
- * A **one-way system** will operate: you enter by the main door and leave to the left or right of the altar (through the Adoration Room or by the side door on the hospital side).
- * **Kneelers** will not be in use. This ensures that people are 2 metres apart at all times.
- * **Holy Communion** will be distributed at the end of Mass; after the Final Blessing, you may receive Communion as you leave the Church (this minimises movement in an enclosed space).
- * **Two collection boxes** on the newsletter tables on either side as you enter, baskets placed at the exits.
- * All Masses will be live-streamed and the 'eight Sunday Masses' per week will be given the **same consideration** in terms of content & length.
- * A **Bottle of Holy Water** is freely available at exits for each household.
- * **Attendance** at last week's Masses: Monday 29, Tuesday 18, Wednesday 36, Thursday 17.

The Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist

It was very disappointing for the Confirmation candidates and for the First Holy Communion children and their families that the Church and the schools were closed because of COVID-19 before they could celebrate the sacraments. We plan now to celebrate Confirmation and First Holy Communion on the first two Saturdays of September, two celebrations each day.
