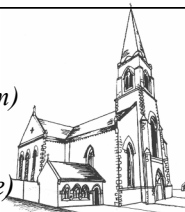

May you recognize in your life the presence, power and light of your soul.

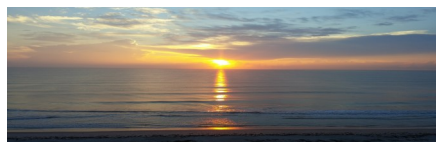
May you realize that you are never alone that your soul in its brightness and belonging connects you intimately with the rhythm of the universe

Ukraine Collection

There will be a collection next weekend to help the people of Ukraine in their hour of need. Collection boxes will be placed in the Church at all Masses.

We will forward your donations to CONCERN. Concern Worldwide has deployed an emergency response team to support the people of Ukraine. More than a million people have fled Ukraine since the Russian invasion began, out of a population of 44 million people. Families, including many small children, are fleeing with whatever clothes and food they can carry, in bitterly cold conditions, often facing huge queues to reach safety. The majority of refugees are currently crossing into Poland, putting huge pressure on existing reception centres.
