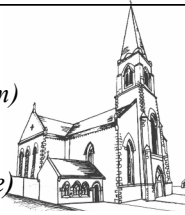

Public Mass and the Sacraments

Everyone is welcome to attend Mass but there is no obligation. In view of the high covid numbers, certain guidelines continue to apply. Face covering, social distancing and using hand sanitiser remain the norm.



Every alternative seat will be in use (with no dividing ribbon in the middle) to ensure social distancing. Kneelers will not be in use to reinforce this and to allow people to cross over in the seat if necessary. In sharing a seat with others outside your circle, please maintain social distance. Please allow others to feel safe in their own space

Communion will be distributed after the Final Blessing, coming forward up the middle, seat by seat, leaving by the sides. This allows for a safer way to leave the church at the end of Mass. Communion will be distributed from two points, in front of the altar and in the centre of the church.

Those who wish to return to their seat for a thanksgiving prayer may do so, following safety directions.
