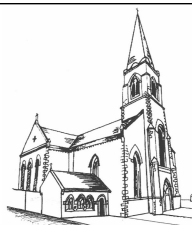

- There are so many Mass Rocks in the area (eight in all) because of the presence of so many soldiers, Killybegs being a garrison town.
